The Kenyan people face conditions of extreme poverty, health crises, including malaria, TB, and HIV/AIDS, lack of access to education, rampant corruption, violence, rapid population growth, and chaotic urbanization. We will witness the commitment of the missioners as they attempt respond to these challenges both by addressing their root causes and the basic needs of the people impacted by them.

What We Will Do There

The trip will focus on the following activities:

1. Visits with Maryknoll Lay Missioners at their ministries; including The Tsavo Children's Village Project, St. Agnes Primary School, St. Patrick's Dispensary, Wezesha organization, Marianist Technical Institute (MTI) and The H.O.P.E. Project.
2. Visits with Kenyans to share the daily routines of their lives – eating and celebrating with them, and seeing life through their eyes.
3. Participation in local liturgical celebrations.
4. Learning about the ancient trading cultures of the Kenyan coast by visiting Fort Jesus and the Old Town of Mombasa and other tours.
5. Experience wildlife in its natural environment on a safari in the Tsavo East National Park.

Maryknoll Lay Missioners (MKLM) in Kenya will introduce us to this dance of life in this beautiful and diverse East African nation. Most know Kenya for her stunning landscapes and abundance of wildlife.
